Sommario/riassunto

This book provides a synopsis of key events, actions taken, and
 authorities invoked by WHO, the U.S. federal government, and state and
 local governments to determine and mitigate the phases of a flu
 pandemic. Additionally, this book addresses select legal issues in
 relation to the pandemic including emergency measures, civil rights,
 liability, and employment issues. Also discussed is the U.S. response to
 global human cases, mandatory vaccination precedents, the potential
 farm sector effects of "swine flu", and the Department of Defense's role
 during a flu pandemic.
