**Sommario/riassunto**

Le management public s'est affirmé comme une discipline académique à part entière, au confluent de courants venus du droit, de l'économie, de la gestion, des sciences politiques ou de la sociologie, et au croisement des pratiques des acteurs publics. Cette Encyclopédie s'adresse à un large public de chercheurs, d'étudiants, de praticiens ou d'élus soucieux d'approfondir et d'élargir leur champ de connaissance, et de trouver une réponse rapide et précise à leurs questionnements. Plus largement, tout citoyen pourra s'y référer pour mieux comprendre comment l'action publique se décide et se conduit. Rédigées par 150 chercheurs et praticiens spécialistes, ses 220 entrées rendent compte des concepts, des théories, des écoles et des modes qui caractérisent le management public, en France comme à l'étranger. Elles les mettent en situation, décrivent leurs contextes ainsi que les modalités et les limites de leur mise en œuvre, éclairant ainsi toutes les phases de l'action publique, depuis sa conception jusqu'à l'évaluation de ses résultats. Un index détaillé permet de les mettre en résonance et expliciter leurs liens. Chaque bibliographie a été soigneusement concentrée sur les références nécessaires.
