Sommario/riassunto	Part of a series of anthologies of classic psychiatric texts In 1999, the World Psychiatric Association established a program where a series of anthologies of classic psychiatric texts were translated from their original language into English. This was launched because English is a scientific language used globally. The first book was published to share major French classical texts.
