Sommario/riassunto	The Russian aggression against Ukraine in February 2022 shook the world and caused immense suffering and destruction in the invaded country. Up to now, the conflict has been highly dynamic: militarily and politically. Ambitions, objectives, and achievements have been as dynamic as the policy of the stakeholders involved.
