Sommario/riassunto	Knjiga opisuje rezultate sedme sezone arheološkega rekognosciranja na jugovzhodu mehiške zvezne države Campeche. Terenski pregledi so bili opravljeni leta 2007 v južnem delu neposeljene Calakmulske biosfere. Površinska keramika in posebnosti arhitekture potrjujejo poselitev od srednje predklasine do zakljune klasine dobe, ugotovljeno že med predhodnimi terenskimi raziskavami, razkrivajo pa tudi povezave s sosednjimi obmoji. Registrirana najdiša so ostanki naselij, ki ustrezajo razlinim hierarhinim razredom. O družbenopolitinem pomenu nekaterih urbanih središ priajo monumentalne ceremonialne in upravne stavbe, pa tudi stele in drugi kamniti spomeniki. Podatki, doslej zbrani na jugovzhodu Campecheja, razkrivajo gostoto in raznovrstnost arheoloških ostankov in pomembno prispevajo k razumevanju družbene organizacije, politine geografije in splošnega kulturnega razvoja Majev v osrednjih nižavjih.
