| Sommario/riassunto | This book seeks a reconsideration of the phenomenon of sorcery and related categories. of a western externalist rationalist understanding of these phenomena without falling into the trap of mysticism. The articles address a diversity of ethnographic contexts in Africa, Asia, the Pacific and the Americas.
