Sommario/riassunto	Focus on Early Childhood: Principles and Realities brings together a wealth of information from various academic and professional standpoints. The authors of this book are from a diverse range of professional and academic disciplines, including education, social work, social policy, psychology and law. Among the topics explored are the concept of quality in early care and education, and the National Curriculum in the primary school.
