Sommario/riassunto	L'Éveil des Muses : le titre du volume de mélanges offert au professeur Édouard Guitton et qui paraît dans la collection « Interférences » des Presses universitaires de Rennes indique clairement qu'il y est question de poésie – et pour l'essentiel, compte tenu de l'époque à laquelle le destinataire a consacré ses recherches, de la poésie des Lumières. Une bonne trentaine de contributions réunissent les plus grands noms du temps : Voltaire, Chénier, Roucher, Parny, Delille... non sans regarder à l'occasion en amont et en aval. Elles laissent aussi place à des écrivains moins attendus (Laclos en versificateur, Rousseau et sa « poésie du cœur »), et à nombre de mineurs, jusqu'à cet abbé Beuf inconnu du catalogue de la BnF. Car le XVIIIe siècle fut un siècle de poètes, il n'y a pas si longtemps qu'on en est assuré, tout particulièrement grâce aux travaux d'Édouard Guitton. Comme le donnent à comprendre les titres des trois sections du volume, « Figures », « Poétiques », « Enjeux », plusieurs approches et méthodes ont été employées, de l'analyse très attentive des textes, aux études théoriques et à l'histoire littéraire. Elles interviennent ici, non en compétition, mais dans une féconde complémentarité : livre d'amis pour un ami, cet Éveil des Muses est un livre savant, qui enrichira aussi bien notre connaissance du XVIIIe siècle que celle du genre auquel il est consacré.

Sommario/riassunto
