Note generali	Each aphorism in the original Greek, Greek verse and Latin prose (by Winterton), and Latin verse (by Fryer). Reprints and completes "Aphorismorum Hippocratis liber primus", Cambridge, 1631; adds the Latin versifications of Fryer's "Hippocratis Coi omnis medicināl parentis Aphorismi versibus scripti", London, 1567. First nine words of the title, and the οἱ in "poëseοἰς", in Greek characters. "Epigrammata regiorum medicināl professorum, Cantabrigiensis atque Oxoniensis, präsidentis et sociorum Collegii celeberrimi Medicorum Londinensium .. In Radulphi Wintertoni metaphrasin nuper editam. .. Quibus accedunt epigrammata therapeutica ejusdem .." has separate dated title page, pagination, and register. The dedication to William Laud is signed "R.W.". Variant 1: dedication signed "Radulphus Winterton". Variant 2: dedication lacking (cancelled?).
