Note generali	<p>First two words of title in Greek characters.</p> <p>Authorship of the Eikon basilike was originally attributed to Charles I, but according to Madan (pp. 125-33) it was written by John Gauden who probably included some authentic writings of the king.</p> <p>Place of publication from Wing; printer's name from Madan who suggests that it was printed "probably for John Williams" (cf. Madan, p. 25); imprint date given according to Lady Day dating.</p> <p>Signatures: A-K¹² (-K12), [3], [paragraph]¶.</p> <p>The "Prayers" have separate pagination and register, with "An epitaph" on verso of final leaf, repeated on verso of the "Eikoìn" title page.</p> <p>Described by Madan as the third state of the "16th edition".</p> <p>Reproduction of the original in the Bodleian Library, Oxford.</p>
