Titolo	Priscianus embryo et Nascens [[electronic resource]] : being a key to the grammar-school. In two parts. I. Very much conduced to the more facil and secure translating either English into Latine, or Latine into English, than fomerly hath been shewn; it being also a Præludium to the Priscianus Ephesus, which is an explanation of this, and a comprehension of most of the difficulties of Latine Syntax.
