Another issue, with cancel title page, of the edition with imprint "London printed by John Wolfe. 1595" but actually printed by Thomas Scarlet (STC 21788). The cancel title is printed by Joan Orwin (STC). Quires [fleuron]-3[fleuron] are indented to cancel I1, but the latter is often present. Leaf 21 misnumbered 17.
