Note generali	The words "Claudii ... Bryennii" are gathered by a right brace, and "Arenarius ... Circuli:" are gathered by a left brace on the title page. With an initial imprimatur leaf dated Mar. 13. 1698/9. and signed Guil Painter Vice-Can. Oxon. With a table of contents, errata, and footnotes. Text is mixed Latin and Greek. With 15 divisional title pages: 7 in Greek and 8 in Latin. Pagination and register begin over again at the ninth divisional title page: Grammatica linguæ Anglicanæ. "Cono-cuneus: or, The shipwrights circular vvedge." has a separate title page dated 1684, and separate pagination and register. Copy partially interleaved. Imperfect: lacks pp. 3-4 (third sequence); with 2 leaves inserted between pp. [8] and [9] at beginning of text. Reproduction of the original in the British Library.
