Note generali	The first two parts are in verse. Printer's name from STC. At foot of title: Cum priuilegio Regiæ Maiestatis. Includes index. "Eirenarchia siue Elizabetha. De pacatissimo Angliæ statu, imperante Elisabetha, compensiosa narratio" (the first word in Greek characters), and "Alexandri Neuilli Kettus, siue de furoribus Norfolcensium Ketto duce liber vnuſ" each have separate date title page; the latter is paginated; register is continuous. In this edition N1v last line begins "Londini". Sheets are sometimes mixed with STC 18773-4--Cf. STC. Part 3 formerly also STC 18479. Part 3 identified as STC 18479 on UMI microfilm reel 1551.
