Note generali	Pts. 2-4 of the Old Testament, the Apocrypha (pt. 5), and the New Testament (pt. 6) each have separate title page, all dated 1579 except the last, which is dated 1580. Imprint to New Testament: Londini, Excudebat Thomas Vautrollerius Typographus, Anno M. D. LXXX [1580] 1580. New Testament has title: Iesv Christi D.N. Novvm Testamentvm e Lingva Syriaca latino sermone redditum. Old Testament title pages have printer's mark, McK. 202; N.T. has printer's mark McK. 170. Head- and tail-pieces; initials; printed marginalia. Tremellius' and Junius' version of the Old Testament, Junius' translation of the Apocrypha, which had first been published at Frankfurt a. M, 1575-1569 and Tremellius' translation of the New Testament, made from the Syriac, first published at Geneva in 1569.
