The copie of a letter sent from Exeter, by a gentleman of quality, to a worthy friend of his dwelling in London [[electronic resource] ] : Shewing, how the enemy have besieged the said city, and how they lye quartered about it: with a true relation of a fight between the citizens and the cavaliers, wherein the citizens took 80. prisoners from them.
