Sommario/riassunto	Afrika ist ein Kontinent jenseits unserer Wahrnehmung. Seit Jahrzehnten wird die mangelnde Qualitat der Afrika-Berichterstattung in deutschsprachigen Medien kritisiert. Zu Recht: Die Uberbetonung von negativen Aspekten wie Burgerkriegen, Hungerkatastrophen und Krankheiten entspricht den aktuellen Entwicklungen auf dem aufstrebenden Erdteil kaum. Afrika heute - das ist auch der Kontinent enormen Wirtschaftswachstums, beispielloser Innovationen und herausragender Personlichkeiten. Warum aber bekommen wir von diesen Entwicklungen nichts mit? Und wie kann die Afrika-Berichterstattung organisiert werden, um eine realistische Darstellung

des Kontinents zu ermöglichen? Das sind die beiden zentralen Fragen, denen Martin Sturmer in seinem Buch nachgeht. Ausgehend von Erkenntnissen der Kommunikationswissenschaft zeigt Sturmer, welche Faktoren und Akteure das gegenwärtige Afrika-Bild beeinflussen. Er dokumentiert schwere journalistische Fehlleistungen und beschäftigt sich mit ihren weitreichenden Folgen auf die Entwicklungsmöglichkeiten des Kontinents und seiner Menschen. Schließlich belegt der Autor auf Basis einer Medienresonanzanalyse, dass eine differenzierte Afrika-Berichterstattung auch unter schwierigen medienökonomischen Bedingungen möglich ist. Sturmer spricht sich für einen Perspektivenwechsel aus, in dem afrikanische Journalisten selbst über ihre Heimatländer berichten.
