Sommarioriassunto

Dieses Inventar liefert erstmalig einen Nachweis über den Verbleib des Schriftgutes zentraler Behörden und Einrichtungen des NS-Staates in allen staatlichen Archiven. In Teil 1 ist das diesbezügliche Archivgut der zehn westdeutschen Länder und Berlin nach einheitlichen Gesichtspunkten erfaßt und beschrieben. Die Gliederung erfolgte nach Verwaltungs- bzw. Organisationseinheiten. Erweiterte Zugriffsmöglichkeiten bieten die getrennten Register für Sachbegriffe, Institutionen, Personen und geographische Begriffe.

This inventory furnishes for the first time the proof of the whereabouts of the records of central authorities and institutions of National Socialist Germany in all state archives. In part 1 the records of West Germany and Berlin regarding to this matter are recorded and described according to a special scheme. The material is structured in administrative and organizing units.
