In <i>Yeshiva Fundamentalism</i> , Nurit Stadler uncovers surprising evidence that firmly religious and pious young men of this community are seeking to change their institutions to incorporate several key dimensions of the secular world: a redefinition

of masculinity along with a transformation of the family, and participation in civic society through the labor mark
