Sommario/riassunto

La révolution néolithique est sans doute l'un des événements majeurs de l'histoire humaine. Indépendamment, dans plusieurs régions du monde, des espèces animales et végétales sont domestiquées, permettant une maîtrise des ressources alimentaires.
